BANTRY,

A SEA-PORT and market town, in the parish of Kilmacomogue, barony of Bantry, county of Cork, is 216 miles s.w. from Dublin, and 51 s.w. from Cork; situated near the western extremity of the county, at the head of, perhaps, one of the finest bays in Ireland--spacious, safe, and commodious for ships of any burthen. This bay is memorable for a naval victory obtained by Admiral Herbert over the French fleet, in the year 1689. Here also a formidable French armament, consisting of fifteen thousand men, destined to invade Ireland, was totally dispersed in the year 1796. This place was anciently called *Kilgoban*, from Saint Goban, its original founder or patron; and its present name, Bantry, from

Beant-Mac-Farriold, a descendant of the O'Donovans and Mahonys, chieftains of the western portion of the country. The town consists chiefly of two streets, parallel with each other, running towards the bay. A new line of road, from Bantry to Kenmare, and thence continued to the celebrated lakes of Killarney, has lately been completed. The Earl of Bantry, who is the proprietor of the town, has an elegant mansion within a quarter of a mile of it, seated on an eminence, commanding a delightful prospect of the bay, with a tract of rich and cultivated country, and in the distance a long chain of stupendous mountains, bold and romantic.
