

CASTLE TOWNSEND is a pleasant marine village, in the parish of Castlehaven, east division of the barony of West Carbery, some county as Skibbereen, between five and five miles east from that town; delightfully situated on the north side of the harbour of Castlehaven. The town, which derives its name from Colonel Townsend, and his seat, the Castle, consists of one long street, and a shorter one diverging, which occupy a gentle declivity descending to the bay. It is well adapted for trade, the harbour being well sheltered, and vessels of five hundred tons burthen can anchor within the haven; fishing, however, is the chief business of the place, and that not extensive. The church of Castlehaven, which stands on a bold eminence above the village, is a neat structure. The Roman Catholic chapel is situated about a mile from the village. Population 770.
