KILLENAULE AND NEIGHBOURHOOD.

KILLENAULE is a small market town, in the parish of its name, barony of Slievardagh, county of Tipperary, 92 miles s.w. from Dublin, 15 s. by e. from Clonmel, and 7 1/2 s. from Fethard; situated on the road between Callan and Cashel, six miles from the former and ten from the latter place, surrounded by a country in a perfect state of cultivation, and thickly studded with seats of an opulent gentry. In the vicinity of the town are wrought some extensive coal, culm, and copper mines, the property of the Mining Company of Ireland and Henry Langley, Esq. of Colebrook. A court of petty sessions is held at Bally-nouty, about a mile from the town, once a fortnight, for judicial affairs connected with the parish and district. Stations of the constabulary force are in the town and at Mardyke.

The places of worship are the parish church, a plain commodious stone edifice, erected on the site of a more ancient building, and a handsome Roman Catholic chapel. The charitable institutions comprise a well-supported dispensary, schools for the gratuitous education of children, Protestant and Catholic, of both sexes, and a loan-fund, called the 'Moyglas Loan-fund,' established in 1842, for the benefit of necessitous and deserving industrious persons. About two miles from the town are the ruins of Graystone Castle: remains also of other ancient buildings are in the neighbourhood, including those of Gralla Castle. The market is on Saturday. Fairs January 6th, March 25th, May 25th, June 24th, and October 17th. The population, in 1841, was 1,786.
