COACHES AND CARS.

To DUBLIN, the *Shareholder*, from the
White Hart Hotel, every Monday, Wed-
nesday and Friday morning at seven;
goes through Lisnaska, Cavan, Vir-
ginia, Kells, Navan and Donshughlia
—also by the conveyances to Drogheda,
thence by Railway.

To ARMAGH, a Car, from Samuel
Betty's, every morning (Sunday ex-
cepted), at six; goes through Maguire's-
bridge, Brookeborough, Five-mile Town,
Clogher, Aughnacloy and Caledon.

To BALLYSHANNON, the *Royal Mail*,
from the White Hart, every morning at
twenty minutes before nine—also by
the Cars to Bundoran.

To BELFAST, the *Royal Mail*, from the
Imperial Hotel, every evening at five;
goes through Lisnaska, Newtown-
Butler, Clones, Monaghan, Middleton,
Armagh, Portadown, Lurgan, Moira
and Lisburn.

To BUNDORAN (during the bathing
season), two Cars, from John Bland's,
