To BELFAST, a Mail Car, from John
Johnson's, every day at a quarter before
one—a Coach, from John Barnett's,
and a Coach, from John Johnson's,
every morning (Sunday excepted) at
half past five; all go through Kircubbin, Grey Abbey and Newtownards.

PORTGLENONE,

A MARKET town, is partly in the parish of Tam-
lightoreilly, and partly in that of Ahoghill, barony of
Loughisholin, but chiefly in its own district parish,
barony of Lower Toome, county of Antrim; 121 miles
N. from Dublin, 42 N. W. from Belfast, 11½ N. W. by W.
from Randalstown, 10 S. by E. from Magherafelt, 8 W.
from Ballymena, 7½ N. by E. from Castle-Dawson, 6
S. S. E. from Kircubbin, and 5 S. by E. from Bellaghy; seated
on the river Bann, on the road from Randalstown to
Kircubbin, and is one of the principal thoroughfares between
the counties of Antrim and Londonderry. An elegant
and newly-built bridge bestrides the Bann, and the
chief portion of the town is the street leading down to
this bridge, containing several well-built houses, the
principal shops and establishments of business, including
its capital inn, the 'Alexander Arms Hotel.' This house,
which is a spacious and conspicuous building, is well
known for its admirable internal arrangements, and its
efficient accommodations as a livery and posting estab-

lishment. The weaving of linen is carried on in the
town and neighbourhood, and there is a trade in grain,
slates, timber and other articles, conveyed in lighters
upon the Bann, which empties itself into the sea below
Coleraine. A court of petty sessions for the county of
Antrim, is held on the third Thursday monthly.
The church, or chapel of ease to Ahoghill, is a neat,
plain, edifice, erected prior to 1729, by the late Bishop
Hutchinson. The other places of worship are three
Presbyterian meeting-houses, and a Wesleyan chapel
in the town, and a Roman Catholic chapel, about a
mile from it. The public schools, of which there are
three, are the principal charities. In the vicinity of the
town is Portglenone House, a superb edifice, built by
Dr. Alexander, bishop of Meath, and now the residence
of his son, Nathaniel Alexander, Esq., M.P. for the
county of Antrim. The market is held on Tuesday,
and the fairs on the first Tuesday in every month. The
town contained, in 1841, 990 inhabitants.

a quarter before eight—Letters from DUBLIN and the SOUTH OF IRELAND, also from ENGLAND, arrive every
day at half-past twelve, and are despatched at a quarter before one.
